Our middle school students are provided with an interactive device such as a Chromebook to use at home and at school. Having a 1:1 program allows students to have continuous access to many online resources including Web 2.0 tools that will assist them in their learning throughout their middle school experience. New tools arise every day. Some common tools that your child may encounter and use with their school issued email address are, but are not limited to:

- **RenWeb:** Our school/home communication portal
- **G-Suite Applications:** i.e. Documents Spreadsheet, Presentation, etc.
- **Google Apps for Education:** i.e. Google +, Docs, Drive, etc.
- **Quizlet:** Online studying tool
- **Wikis:** a wiki is a website that allows visitors to add, remove and edit content online
- **Podcasts:** A podcast is a digital audio file that is distributed over the Internet for playback on portable media players and personal digital devices
- **WeVideo:** video editing software site
- **Khan Academy, iReady, IXL:** Offers practice exercises, instructional videos, and a personalized learning.
- **Scratch, Code.org, CodeAcademy.com:** Web-based programming application websites
